 4. "Saving Your Marriage Before It Starts", written by Dr. Les Parrott & Dr. Leslie Parrott. This book is a Gold Medallion Award winner, designed for those who are preparing for their marriages.  5. "Preparing for Marriage Workbook" edited by Dennis Rainey, authors are David Boehi, Brent Nelson, et al. One of the best resource for marriage preparation class (I use this resource for the classes I lead at KCPC). To get the most benefit out of this book, start working on this material well in advance – like 6-8 month before the wedding. The earlier you start, the better you will be.
 6. "The Act of Marriage" by Dr. Tim & Beverly LaHaye. Or "Intended for Pleasure" by Ed and Gaye Wheat. Offers distinctively Christian instruction on the intimacy and physical dimension of the marriage.
