Romans 1:2-7

---

In Romans 1:1 Paul, introduced as a servant of Jesus, called to be an apostle, and chosen for the gospel, explains three things in today's passage: what is the gospel, who is Jesus Christ, being the heart of the gospel, and what gospel-owned Christians will live for. Through the Word, I hope we fully understand the gospel and make a commitment to our calling.

1. In verse 2, how does Paul explain the gospel? Take a look at how the promised word regarding God's son, Jesus Christ, is in the Old Testament. How was Jesus' coming fulfilled in the holy Scriptures? Within what God promised us, what are we waiting to be fulfilled?
2. Take a look at verses 3 and 4 and share what the Bible says about Jesus' human nature and His divine nature. What do you think is the difference between the name Jesus Christ and Jesus Christ "our Lord"? Share when Jesus Christ became "my" Jesus Christ.
3. Christians not only receive salvation from God, but like the apostle, we also receive a calling (verse 5). Do you have gratitude and joy from the saving grace of God? At the same time, are you living with the recognition that you are called with a purpose?
4. Those who have experienced the gospel have a clear purpose in life. It is to lead the non-believers to the Lord to trust and obey, with an apostle-like calling engraved in the heart. Is there someone you wish to evangelize this year? Take this time to share who you will evangelize and pray together.

**Emphasized during the Sunday sermon**

- "God gives grace to those he loves, but those who love God follow the calling. When you receive grace, you receive the same calling as the apostle"
- "After receiving the saving grace, we are not simply religious people who leisurely enjoy a cruise but should join in fighting the spiritual battle toward the salvation of souls for Jesus. Jesus gave his life for us by dying on the cross. It would be an embarrassment if the day comes when we come before the Lord and we have not fulfilled our calling."
