Romans 1:8-17

In today's sermon, Paul explains the reason he wrote the book of Romans. Although the church in Rome was known to be of good faith, Paul wrote with a desire to remind them of the gospel that saves. Through the Word, God desires for us to hear His voice and be excited about the gospel.

1. What was the reason behind Paul's desire to visit the church in Rome? (verse 15). What kind of church was the Roman church at the time? (verse 8). Known throughout the world as a faithful church, what does Paul's attempt to re-tell the gospel to the saints in Rome show of the spiritual situation of the Roman church at the time?
2. In light of Paul's desire to preach the gospel to the church in Rome, who do you think needs to listen to the gospel today?? What is the problem with the idea that the gospel should only be shared to those who do not believe?
3. The gospel is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes (verse 16). Only the righteous shall live by faith (verse 17). Keep in mind the idea that the path of salvation lies in the goodness of man and in the grace of God. Share what the Bible says about salvation (refer to Ephesians 2:8).
4. Have you ever met a believer who has been deeply moved by salvation and lives a life full of gratitude and joy? How would a person like that affect you? Am I deeply moved by salvation, therefore live with gratitude and joy? How can being deeply moved by salvation increase the excitement of gratitude and joy in life? If you have experience this, please share with the group.
5. Paul, who knew the gospel of salvation, was thrilled to tell everyone his obligation to share the gospel. It was because of his obligation that he was able to convey the gospel of truth, even as he was headed to Rome, where death awaited. The thrill of salvation is connected to a soulful heart. Do I have an indebted heart? In your small group, pray for the person you have chosen last week to evangelize.

Emphasized during the Sunday sermon

- "Salvation does not happen when we decide to believe in God. It happens through the grace of God when God decides to love us".
- "When you soak your soul with the gospel, you will not be stained by anything in the world. When you become a slave to the gospel, you become a truly free person"
