Romans 1:18-32

In today's passage, Paul speaks on what seems to be the antithesis of God's love. He writes about the wrath of God. The manifestation of the wrath of God occurs in the presence of ungodliness and unrighteousness. The sin of ungodliness stems from a broken relationship with God. The sin of unrighteousness stems from the relationship with sinful people. Through the Word, I hope we come to realize our identity and the love of God who saves us.

1. What are the characteristics of people whom God reveals His wrath to? (verse 19) Describe the life of an ungodly person (vv. 21-25), and the life of an unrighteous person (vv.26-32). In light of this passage, no one can say they are free from these sins. What are some specific sins from this passage that you are struggling with?
2. Paul states that exchanging the glory of the immortal God for something else is an idol (v.23). Look for examples of idolatry in the Bible and share the possible reasons for creating them. Paul Tripp once said, "If we feel disappointed, discouraged, or despaired over someone or of our work, it means our heart is not focused on God but on something else." In light of Tripp's famous words, are you relying on God right now or are you in the position of worshipping idols?
3. The most terrifying judgment of God is when He "gives up" on you (vv. 24, 26, 28). In what way is this the most terrifying judgment?
4. Today, the issue of homosexuality has become an uncomfortable and dangerous topic to deal with. How does the Bible address this issue? (vv. 24-27) What am I doing so that I am living according to what the biblical teaches? How am I raising my children in the midst of the changing cultures and values of this world? Is there anything we need?
5. All humans have become subject to the wrath of God. How does God feel when He sees the people made in His image abandon Him and live ungodly and in unrighteousness? In 2 Timothy 3:13-14 Paul writes, "while evil people and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed". As you have been reading the Bible for 20 minutes and praying for 20 minutes (B20P20), share the blessings you received and pray for a greater commitment to the Word and prayer.
