## A N N O U N C E M E N T S

### 1. Online Worship Transition

Until further notice, all group worships will take place online.

### 2. Sunday Worship

- Online worship services also available for weekday early morning prayer (5:30am) and Wednesday evening service (7:30pm).

### 3. Easter Sunday

Next week we will be celebrating Easter Sunday! If you'd like to give a special offering for Easter, please select that option when giving online (go to kcpc.org). You can also write a check (written out to KCPC) and mail it to the church address (15451 Lee Hwy, Centreville VA 20121).

### 4. Passion Week Evening Services

- 4/6 (Mon) - 4/10 (Fri) 7:30pm, 4/11 (Sat) 6:30am).
- Theme: Rediscovering the Cross. All services will be held in both English and Korean.
- We do not offer early morning worship during this period.
- We will partake in the Lord's Supper together online (please prepare bread and juice for your family).

### 5. KCPC Cares

- Those in need may pick up a bag of rice (2 max) at the Kiss & Ride entrance of the church on Tues-Sat from 9:00am-3:00pm.
- Local churches with rental fees of less than \$3000 per month may apply for assistance by 4/6 (Tue).
- Those who want to contribute to the KCPC Cares Fund may do so when giving online or mail a check to the church.

### 6. Online Giving

- If you are using an email to give online that is not on file with your church membership, the church will send an email for verification to confirm/register your email.

## Good Friday Love Feast Instructions

Date and time: April 10, 7:30pm, (Location: Your home)

### Items needed

1. Food that is easily shareable (bread, rice cake (떡), snacks etc.)
2. Grape or any other kind of juice

### Order

1. We will partake in the Love Feast immediately after the benediction of the Good Friday worship
2. We will share the bread and juice by the direction of the senior pastor
3. Everyone will read out loud the communal prayers together as a family
4. Afterward, we will have fellowship and share the love of Jesus with our family members

### Q&A for the Love Feast

1. Is Love Feast biblical?

The New Testament early church shared the love of Christ by sharing their food with the community. Through their fellowship they felt the love of Jesus and spiritual grew together.

2. Are there any conditions that need to be met before partaking in the Love Feast?

Unlike Holy Communion, there are no conditions that need to be met for the Love Feast. It is a time of sharing the love of Jesus with those around us.

3. What is the difference between Communion and Love Feast?

- Holy Communion was first administered by Jesus Himself (Matthew 26:26-30). The Love Feast is grounded on the love of Jesus and was an activity done by the early church. They shared their food with one another as we would do at a potluck.
- The Holy Communion can only be taken by baptized individuals who repented of their sins. The Love Feast has no conditions and is partaken by all in sharing the love of Jesus.
- The Holy Communion is a sacrament of remembering the body and blood of Jesus Christ. The Love Feast is a time of sharing the love (agape) of Jesus through food and fellowship.
- Holy Communion is only administered by ordained ministers as it is stated in the PCA Book of Church Order. The Love Feast is shared by any person. Although there are differences in practice between the denominations, the Holy Communion and Love Feast should be done with holy reverence to God.
